Negative Coggins test, taken within 12 months of Show, is required and must be submitted with entries. An office fee of \$1.00 will be charged if copies of Coggins are made. Horses must qualify for stake classes.

Entries close March 8, 2010. Entries made after this date will be charged a \$10.00 post entry fee. Fees must be paid before back numbers are issued.

**ALL ACCOUNTS MUST BE SETTLED BY 6:00 PM ON MARCH 20<sup>st</sup>.**

The facility has 440 permanent stalls. Please make stall reservations early to ensure availability. Stalls are available at \$70.00 each. No initial bedding provided. Reservations will be made upon receipt of \$70.00 per stall rental fee. Stall preference will be given to class sponsors. Stalls **WILL NOT** be available until 12:00 noon on Wednesday, March 17<sup>th</sup>. **STALL REFUNDS WILL NOT BE MADE AFTER MARCH 8<sup>th</sup> UNLESS STALLS CAN BE RENTED TO SOMEONE ELSE.** Shavings may be ordered on entry form. Bulk shavings **MAY NOT** be brought in from outside Garrison Arena. Shavings **MUST** be purchased at the Show Grounds. A grounds fee of \$10.00 per horse will be charged for non-stalled horses. ## ACADEMY DIVISION

The purpose of this division is to introduce potential owners to the joys of showing horses and give riders the opportunity to gain experience in a fun, horse show atmosphere.

The AMERICAN SADDLEBRED ASSOCIATION OF THE CAROLINAS sanctions these classes. A complete copy of the rules and regulations governing these classes is available at the horse show office.

**RIDERS:** Riders in this division are students who are enrolled in a professionally operated program and are to be judged on their basic riding skills. Riding suits are NOT allowed; jodhpur boots and pants are suggested. Riders may NOT cross enter into any performance classes with the exception of driving classes. A rider that has shown in a regular division or in a full riding suit is prohibited from further participation in the Academy division with the EXCEPTION of Show Rider Practice.

**HORSES:** Horses are to be lesson type horses! These horses must display the characteristics of such! **Horses MUST be flat-shod.** Instructors are encouraged to own or lease their academy horses. Horse may be shown in a snaffle bridle with a martingale, pelham or full bridle with a flat cutback English saddle. Hoofblackening will be optional and braiding is NOT allowed. Horses CANNOT be **CROSS-ENTERED** into the performance division at the same show. Soundness is not to be considered. **HORSES ARE NOT TO BE JUDGED.**

**While rules may be different in other states, horses from programs outside of the Carolinas MUST abide by these rules while showing at shows in North and South Carolina.** Anyone NOT abiding by these rules, or horses that are deemed to be a danger, will be eliminated by Horse Show Management and UPHA Chapter 12 Representative.

**NOTE:** Academy entries **must** be received in show office by 5:00 PM Friday to avoid a late penalty.
