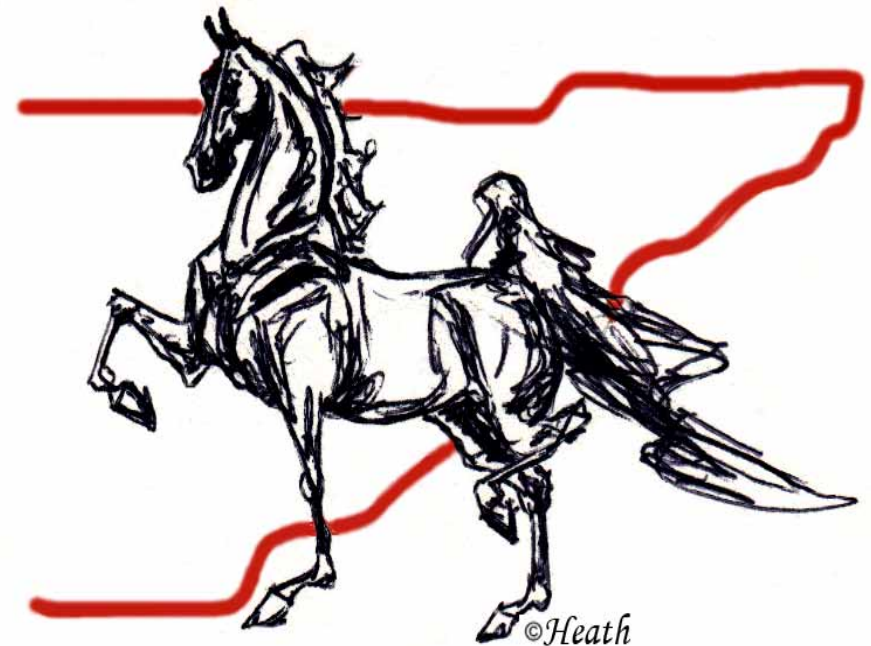

ASHA Junior Judging Contest

The East Tennessee Saddlebred Association is proud to announce the addition of a **Junior Judging Contest** to the 2009 ETSA Midsummer Classic Horse Show. The contest will be governed by guidelines from the American Saddlebred Horse Association, Inc (ASHA). They are as follows:

1. All participants (juniors) must be *under* twenty (20) years of age.
2. A participant must judge a minimum of four (4) classes but no more than six (6) classes. Classes must have a minimum of four (4) entries. A list of classes from which the participants may choose will be posted on the horse show office door no later than **Friday morning, August 7th**.
3. Participants must register to participate in the horse show office prior to the show session in which their first chosen class is scheduled.
4. All junior judges must report to the designated judging area prior to the start of his/her chosen classes.
5. Judging cards will be supplied. Participants are asked to supply writing instruments. No other aides are permitted in the designated judging area.

More detailed rules will be available in the horse show office.

The designated judging area will be identified prior to the show. The show reserves the right to split participants into two (2) age divisions if deemed necessary by officials.

Tabulation will be conducted by horse show officials. All results are final. An awards ceremony will be held during the Saturday evening session. All participants are encouraged but not required to attend.

ETSA Midsummer Classic Horse Show Rules

The East Tennessee Saddlebred Association
Midsummer Classic Horse Show is operated in
the spirit of the U.S. Equestrian Federation rules.

Entries—Entries close on **Friday, July 17, 2009** and must be postmarked by that date. Any entries received after this date will be considered **post entries** and must pay a **\$10.00 per horse** post entry fee. Academy rider entries will not be charged the post entry fee. **The entry office will close one (1) hour before each session.** Anyone needing to make an emergency entry after the office has closed will be assessed a **\$25.00 emergency entry fee plus normal entry fees and post entry fees.**

Open Checks—The Horse Show requires that a **SIGNED** open check be left with the entry office for all tab accounts. No back numbers will be issued without an open check. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor or agent to settle his or her account by the end of the show. Upon failure to do so, the horse show manager will fill in the correct amount on the open check and the exhibitor or agent relinquishes the right for adjustment after leaving the show.

Stalls & Stall Reservations—Stalls and tack stalls are **\$70.00** each if **reserved and paid for by July 17, 2009.** After this date, stalls will be **\$80.00 each. NO STALLS WILL BE ASSIGNED UNTIL THE FEE IS PAID.** No open checks or phone calls will be accepted for stall reservations. Stalls will be available on **Wednesday, August 5th.** Early arrivals on **Tuesday, August 4th** or before will be charged **\$12.00 per stall.**

Stall Assignment Policy—Stalls will be assigned by the show management to most efficiently use available stalls.

Refunding of Fees—A **full refund** will be given to anyone who cancels their entries **before the closing date of July 17, 2009.** After the closing date, stall refunds will be given only if the stalls are re-rented. Entry fees will be refunded to anyone who cancels up to one (1) hour prior to the start of the session in which they are showing. Once the office has closed for the session, no entry fees will be refunded. If an entry misses a class, the fee will not be refunded.

Academy Division
Flat Shod or 1/4" Therapeutic Pad Only
All Entry Fees are \$15.00

The academy division is designed for inexperienced riders who are to be judged on their basic riding skills. Horses are to be school or academy type horses. **Riders/drivers may not cross enter in any other classes and must have only shown in academy classes at other shows.** No riding suits allowed and only jodhpur pants, boots, and vests are suggested. Helmets are encouraged. Horses may cross enter in other classes at the show with a rider that is not in the academy division. Academy classes will be split if more than 8 entries. It is the responsibility of the trainer or instructor to provide horses for their riders.

Prize Money—Premiums will be mailed within thirty (30) days after the close of show. Prize money will be credited to the agent's account. Persons wishing to receive their own prize money must send in a separate entry blank with current agent information listed.

Returned Checks—All returned checks will be charged a **\$50.00** return check fee.

Bedding—Bedding will be available for purchase for **\$6.00 per bag** between the hours of **8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.** Bedding may also be ordered for pre-arrival delivery on the enclosed order form. Payment or an open check must accompany pre-arrival orders.

Qualification for Championship Classes—All horses must qualify for championship classes in an appropriate qualifying class. Stake classes are not considered qualifying classes and do not qualify horses for entry in any championship. Riders showing in a no canter class cannot cross enter in a canter class except in the Youth Hackney Pony Under Saddle class and Friesian classes.

Amateur Owned and Trained Classes—Exhibitors, attendants, and headers must meet the U.S. Equestrian specifications for amateur status. Horses are not to have been professionally trained during the sixty (60) days prior to the show (riding and driving instruction excluded). In addition, horses are not to be presented, prepared, groomed, or schooled with the aid of a professional during the show. Horses may be stabled and hauled with a professional during the competition. Professional help for situations relevant to safety is permitted.

ETSA Member Classes—These classes are limited to current ETSA members. Exhibitors paying membership fees prior to the classes will be eligible to compete. A membership form is enclosed and will be available in the horse show office.

Junior Exhibitor Classes—Junior Exhibitor classes are limited to riders 17 years of age and younger.

Denver Junior Horse Classes— These classes are for horses 5 years of age and younger.

Novice Horse—A Novice horse is any horse that has not won three (3) blue ribbons in the given division at any show, regardless if the show was recognized or unrecognized.

Alpha/Novice Rider Classes—Riders may compete in this division if they are classified as an **Alpha Rider** - riders just coming out of the Academy division and/or adult riders who have not shown in a ten (10) year period. An alpha rider has **two (2) years** to compete in this division regardless of the number of blue ribbons they have won **OR** Riders may be classified as a **Novice Rider**—riders who have not previously won three (3) blue ribbons at any show regardless if it was recognized or unrecognized.

Splitting Classes—When the classes listed below exceed the specified number of entries, they will be split. In cases where classes are split, only the ribbon winners will be allowed to show back in the appropriate championship classes. Championship classes will not be split.

Classes under the following conditions will be split:

· **Junior Exhibitor** classes with more than **18 entries**

· **Adult Under Saddle** classes with more than **20 entries**

· **Fine Harness, Show Pleasure Driving, Country Pleasure Driving, and Road Pony** classes with more than **12 entries**

· **Road Horse** classes with more than **12 entries**

· **Academy** classes with more than **8 entries** (Please see academy section for championship splits.)

Discipline—Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver, or groom shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit all fees. In the case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall take the prize that had been awarded to the disqualified horse.

Attention Getting Devices—Items such as tape measures, blow horns, split bamboo poles, whistles, or whips longer than six (6) feet that would alter the performance of a horse or disturb another horse will not be allowed at the entrance of the show ring, ring side, or in the warm-up rings. Explosives, fire extinguishers, and laser light beams are prohibited on the show grounds before, during, and after the show. All such items will be confiscated.

Warm-Up Ring Procedure—The next class on the schedule has priority for the use of the ring.

Hackney Pleasure Pony Division

To be shown to a suitable two-wheeled vehicle with appropriate harness. To be shown at a flat walk, trot, and road trot. Extreme speed will be penalized. Must stand quietly and back readily. Quarter boots are prohibited. USEF rules will apply. All championship classes require qualification in a preliminary class on Thursday, Friday, or Saturday.

(This class is open to all English equitation riders 12 years of age and over, with a mental or physical handicap, riding a mare or gelding of any breed. It is open to walk and trot riders only. Rider may never have been judged in a class at a recognized or non-recognized show that required a canter. English equipment shall be used. They may also use protective and adaptive equipment necessary to them and to the division in which they show, as long as it conforms with the U.S. national rules governing riders with disabilities.)

Addition of Classes

No classes will be moved either forward or back. \$250 will be charged to add a class.

Road Pony Division

Classes restricted to ponies 54" and under. To be shown at a jog trot, road gait, and then at speed. Driver to wear stable colors, jacket and cap to match. Helmets mandatory in all Junior Exhibitor classes. USEF rules will apply. All championship classes require qualification in a preliminary class on Thursday, Friday, or Saturday.

Campers—Hookups are available for **\$20.00 per day/night** on a first-come, first serve basis.

Ring Closing—The show ring will be open Wednesday 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. and Thursday—Saturday open at 7:00 a.m. and close one (1) hour prior to each session and one (1) hour after each evening performance providing the show ends by 11:00 p.m. The covered warm up ring and outdoor ring will be available 24 hours.

Trailer & Vehicle Parking—All trailers and vehicles must be parked in designated areas. Absolutely no trailer or vehicle parking will be permitted in the barn area. The fire code dictates that fire lanes must be left open on all sides of the barns in case of emergency.

Vandalism—Vandalism of the stalls, facilities, or grounds owned by the Walters State Great Smoky Mountains Expo Center will result in the assessment of a \$500 fee for each incident of vandalism and any additional cost.

Dogs on Show Grounds—Must be on a leash at all times.

Golf Cart Use—Please exercise discretion in the use of **golf carts, scooters, or any motorized vehicles. All drivers must have a valid drivers license. Children without a valid driver's license WILL NOT be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind.** Violations of this rule will result in the confiscation of the vehicle and a fine of \$50 made payable to the show. Remember, horses have the right-of-way!

Protest—If you wish to protest a class, please see horse show management. There will be a charge of \$100 until the protest is resolved. If the protest is in your favor, you will be refunded the \$100. If the protest is not in your favor, you forfeit the \$100. The horse that is being protested may be asked for registration papers.

Show Committee—Reserves the right to decline to receive any entry and to return any entry fee and/or stable fee before or during the show, without being liable for compensation. Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final. The show committee of the East Tennessee Saddlebred Association, Midsummer Classic Horse Show, the Walters State Great Smoky Mountain Expo Center, nor any sponsor will be responsible for any accident which may occur to any owner, vendor, spectator, driver, rider, groom, attendance animal, or equipment at the show.

ASB Country Pleasure Division

Open to ASB mares and geldings to be ridden or driven by an amateur. Horses must be plain shod without pads, bands, bars, or attachments. All entries must be shown with a full mane and tail. Tails must not be gingered or put in any device such as a tailset, bustle, or brace, which may alter their carriage, while on the show grounds. USEF rules will apply. All championship classes require qualification in a preliminary class on Thursday, Friday, or Saturday.

Horses showing in the Natural Country Pleasure shall be keg-shod and carry a shorter, natural length foot (no handmade or weighted shoes). Extreme motion will be penalized and horses' tails are to be unset. Horses who appear to have worn tail sets in preparation for the show will be penalized.

Horses shown in this division are ineligible to show in the Saddlebred performance division or the Saddlebred pleasure division at the same show. To be shown with a full mane and tail at a walk, trot, and canter. Horses will be asked to back. Horses may be shown by a professional or an amateur. Horses may wear tailsets or bustles, but may not show with the tail gingered, tied, or braced. Unset tails will not be penalized. Braids and inconspicuously applied hair in the mane and tail are permitted. Shoe bands and pads are permitted. USEF rules will apply. All championship classes require qualification in a preliminary class on Thursday, Friday, or Saturday.
